



## Policy - Requests for Andrew's Memorial Courses Grant

The Society will consider grant applications for part funding of Adult Education Courses, to dDeaf individuals provided the following criteria are reached.

1. The applicant submits a request in writing to the Chairperson of the Jersey dDeaf Society, stating the reasons why a particular course would be of personal benefit to them.
2. The applicant shows that they are (a) of low income or (b) have financial hardship or (c) have insufficient personal funds pay the full cost of a course.
3. The applicant must be a resident of the Island of Jersey and lived in Jersey continuously for at least 1 year prior to the date of an application.
4. The applicant will pay 25% of the overall course fee and the Society will pay the remaining 75%, which will be to a limit £225.
5. The applicant will pay in full any examination costs and any materials not included in the course fee.
6. If successful applicant does not attend at least 75% of the course hours, for any reason other than a medical one, they will pay back anything paid by Jersey dDeaf Society.
8. Only one grant per applicant, per academic year (September-July), will be considered by the Committee.
